

League Policies

Requests/Conflicts:

Every team is responsible for inputting scheduling requests/conflicts during team registrations before the season starts. If you forget to add these notes to your team registration you can send an email to zeke@michigansportsacademies.com with your requests before the session's deadline to avoid any rescheduling fees.

24-hour Scheduling Rule:

We will publish the league schedule 1 week before the start date. Once it's published, your team has 24 hours to tell us if there has been a mistake in the schedule **based off** your requests/conflicts stated during registration. If your team did not put any requests such as day preference, time conflicts, dates of importance, etc, we will not change your schedule. That will then go to the forfeiting and rescheduling policies.

Rescheduling:

The team requesting the reschedule of a game is to pay a \$30 rescheduling fee. Leah or Zeke will then work on looking for possible dates/times available for the game to be played. The new game date/time must suffice for the opposing team involved.

Forfeiting:

If a team may forfeit, they are to call/email Zeke **and** Leah before 2pm the day of (or earlier) to avoid possible suspension from future sessions. The opposing team is still granted the field for the time the game was supposed to be played.

Dropping out:

Teams that are no longer available to play may drop out by emailing Zeke or Leah **before** the registration deadline to receive 100% of the deposit back. Teams that want to drop out any time after the registration deadline will **not** receive their deposit back. This includes after the schedule is posted, during the season, etc.
